## ICELAND TOLLUR CANCELS

Tollur means Customs. From 1st January 1913 to 30th November 1938, Customs Duty on imports was collected by the Post Office, using postage stamps. The stamps were affixed to the import document ("Fylgibréf") as proof of payment of Customs Duty. Up to 14th March 1920 the stamps were cancelled with regular postmark; then up to 31st December 1921 they were additionally perforated by sewing machine or needle. These perforated stamps are rare as collectors considered them damaged and threw them away. From 1st January 1922 to 31st March 1924, regular postmarks alone were used. From 1st April to August, pen cancels seem to have been used.

Then on 1st August 1924, "Tollur" cancels were employed. One stamp (often the lowest value) received a postal cds to indicate the date, while the balance of stamps received "Tollur" cancels. The cancels were applied in various positions, either fully over the individual stamp, bridging a pair of stamps, or tying the stamp to the document. Most current definitive postage stamps of the period were used, along with a few commemoratives. The 1930 Parliament Millenary set and the 1934 Airmails were specifically excluded from "Tollur" use by legislation (though both are actually found with "Tollur" cancels). The other airmail and charity surtax stamps, or special stamps such as officials, were generally not used by postal officials for tax collection (though some are occasionally found with Tollur cancels).

As the amounts to be paid as tax tended to be higher than normal postage rates, high value definitives saw frequent use, while the low aur values were used relatively infrequently and tended to receive the postal cds. It is a commonly held view that "Tollur" cancels are all worth less than postally used stamps, but for the revenue collector, the low values or special issues are elusive and some command a premium well over those more commonly used as postage stamps.

SG numbers are quoted for this section by kind permission of Stanley Gibbons Ltd. All prices are for stamps with "Tollur" cancel (whether or not the illustration shows them this way). The few indicated only in

brackets are those not yet recorded, in the series where others saw use for collection of "Tollur" tax.
