

LIECHTENSTEIN REVENUE

Liechtenstein is an independent principality on the border between Austria and Switzerland. In the 19th Century Austrian influence was predominant; after WWI Liechtenstein made its main economic links with Switzerland. A few Austrian revenues are known used in the 19th Century in Liechtenstein but all are rare. Most revenues were used on documents which were retained by the state and later destroyed under supervision; the few surviving Liechtenstein revenues are thus odd mint examples which have survived in offices by chance, or remainders from the period of the adoption of Swiss currency in 1920.

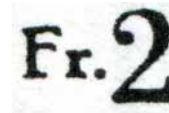

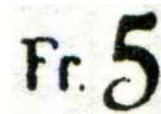

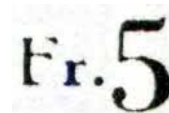
